Support an event: We have several fundraising events every year and would welcome sponsors to assist us with or donate advertising space, goodie bags, banners, prizes, etc.

ARE YOU INTERESTED AND WANT TO KNOW MORE ABOUT THE CCRT?

The Canadian Chihuahua Rescue and Transport is a national, registered charity dedicated to finding "forever homes" for the dogs that you will be helping. Our volunteers have been actively rescuing and rehoming Chihuahua's and Chihuahua mixed breed dogs since 1999. We are particularly proud of that fact that we have placed almost 300 dogs into loving homes since that time.

Rescuing a dog involves routine veterinary care, such as spaying/neutering, vaccinations, microchipping and dental work, that averages \$500 per dog. As the CCRT receives a large number of older dogs, dogs with special needs and dogs that require emergency surgeries, these costs can easily soar to over \$2000 for a single animal. These costs do not include the everyday necessities they require while in foster care. We do this work, day in and day out, as we never want to look into the eyes of a lonely, abused or aching dog and not do **everything** we can to help them. Please consider helping us so we can continue to help them.
